

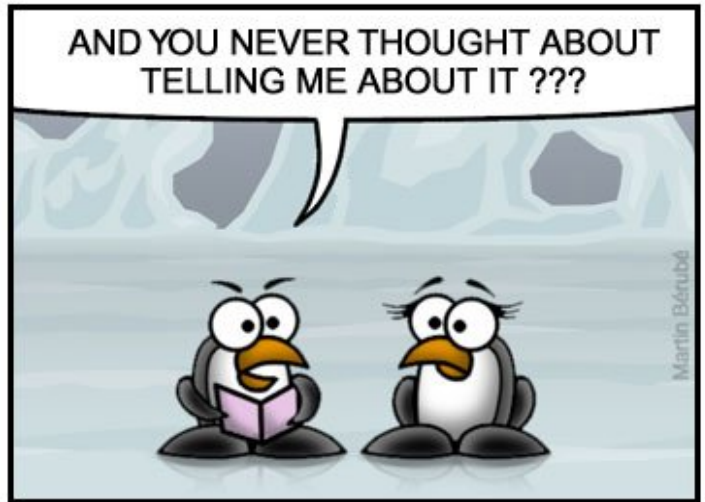
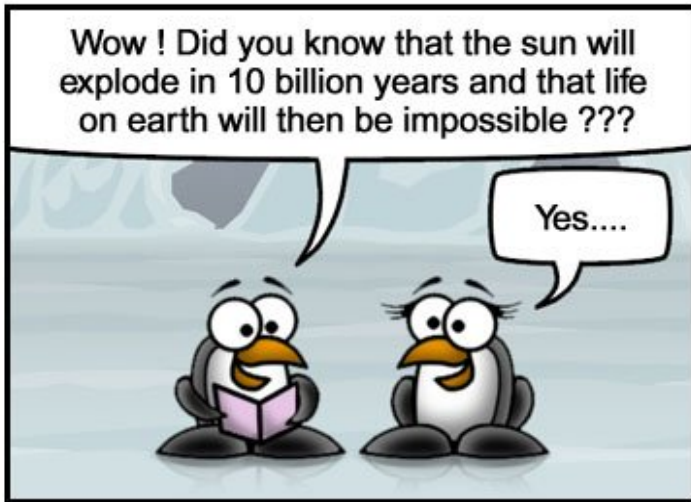
The penguins



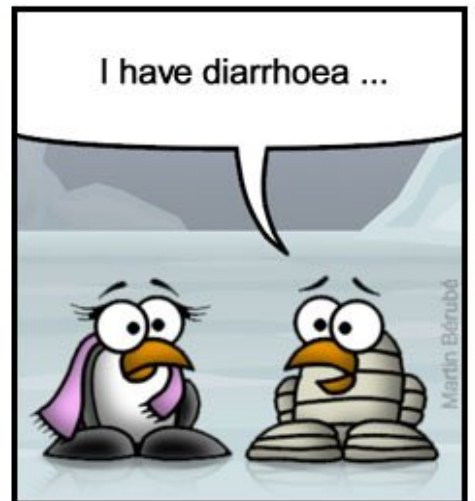
